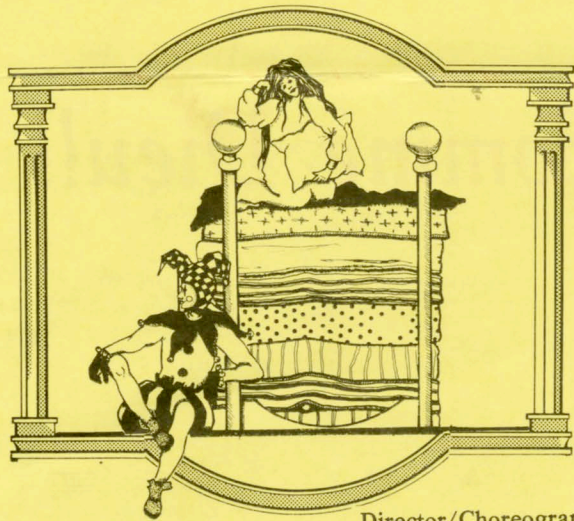

Once Upon A Mattress

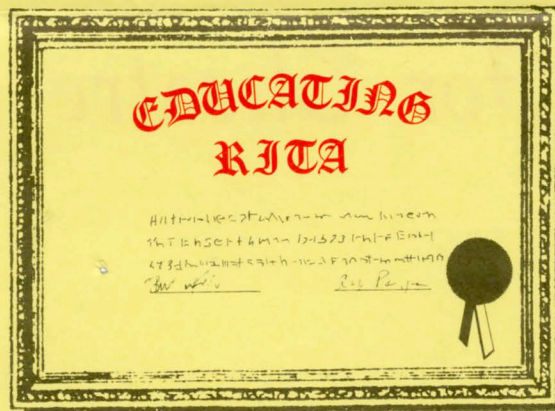

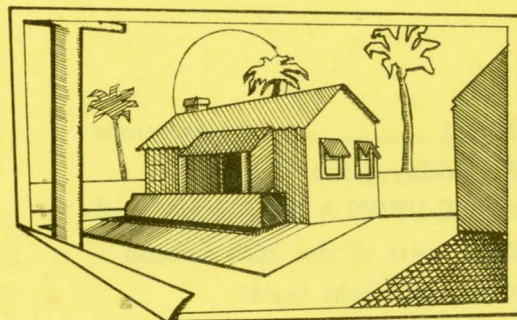


Talley's Folly

I Ought To Be In Pictures

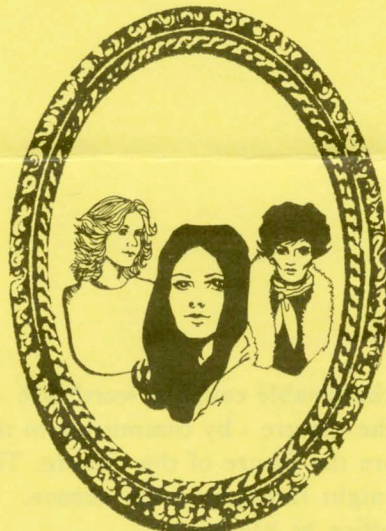

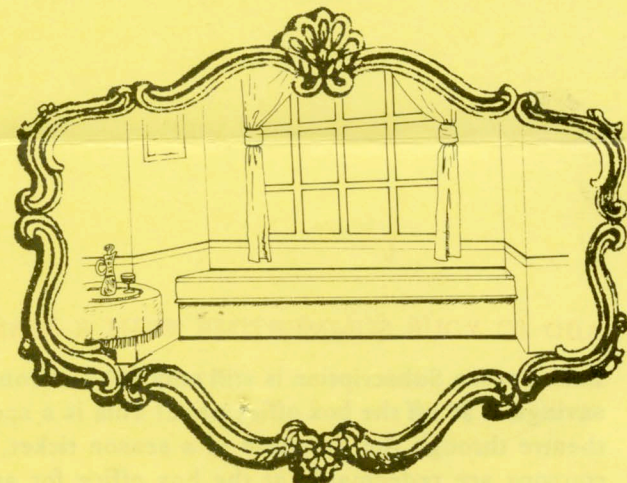

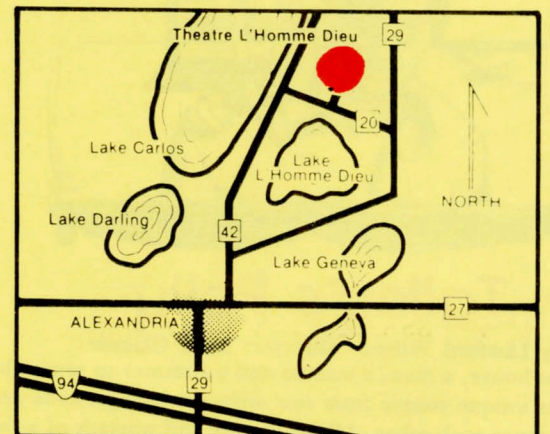
